Remedy claimed or relief sought:

1. An Order pursuant to Rule 7-9 of *The King's Bench Rules* and the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court striking out or setting aside the Applicant's Originating Application and Amended Originating Application as against Saskatchewan Power Corporation and Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan;

2. An Order pursuant to Rules 11-1, 11-7, and 11-8 of *The King's Bench Rules* and the inherent jurisdiction of this Honourable Court for costs of this application and the Origination Application and Amended Originating Application;
3. An Order setting down this matter for a Special Chambers hearing, on a date set by the Local Registrar and agreed upon by the parties; and
4. Such further and other relief as counsel may advise and this Honourable Court may allow.

Grounds for making the application:

5. The Originating Application and Amended Originating Application disclose no reasonable claim as against the Respondents, Saskatchewan Corporation and Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan.
6. The Originating Application and Amended Originating Application fail to raise justiciable issues.
7. In these circumstances, the Court should exercise its discretion to award costs pursuant to Rules 11-1, 11-7, and 11-8.
8. Pursuant to General Application Practice Directive #11 (GA-PD #11), the maximum time limit for oral presentation in Chambers is 30 minutes for the applicant, and 30 minutes for the respondent.
9. The parties have discussed this matter and expect that oral arguments will surpass the time limits for oral presentation in Chambers.
10. The Applicants, Saskatchewan Power Corporation and Crown Investments Corporation of Saskatchewan, apply for an order directing the matter be referred to the Local Registrar to be set for a special Chambers hearing.
